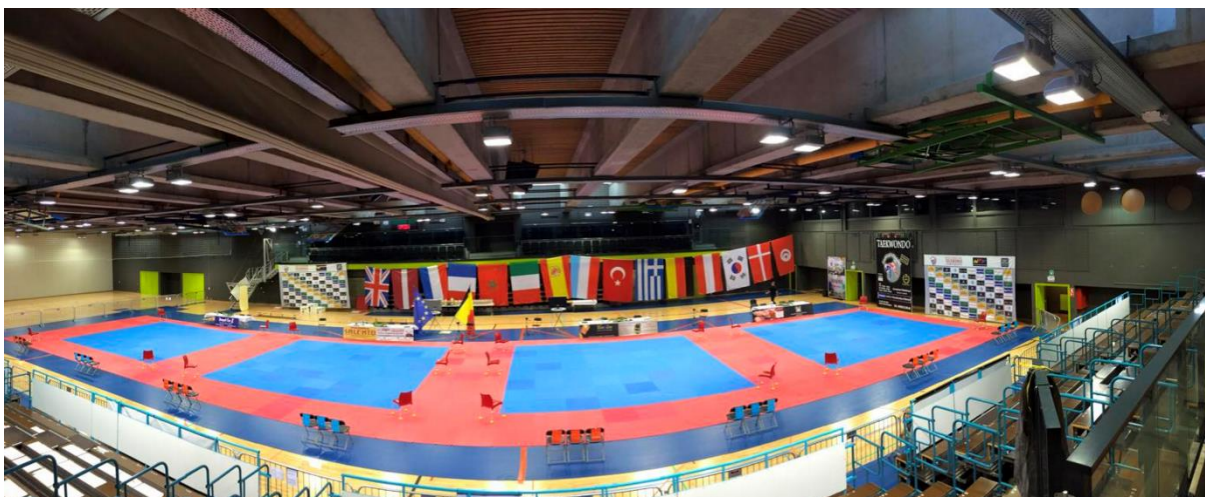

Electronic head protectors will be used categories where head kicks are allowed. - All competitors must provide their own Daedo electronic sensor socks. - Competitors from categories where head kicks are not allowed must provide their own head protector. 																				
3.6 Invidividual Awards	<p>The 1st, 2nd and 3rd of each category will be awarded with a gold, silver and bronze medal respectively. Medals will be awarded at the end of each fight. Three trophies will be awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fair-play trophy (club) - Best referee trophy - Best fighter trophy 																				
3.7 Team Awards	<p>Points for the final team ranking will be awarded as follows: 1 point for each competitor entering the competition after the weigh-in 1 point for each fight won 7 points per gold medal 3 points per silver medal 1 point per bronze medal</p> <p>In the event of a tie, the ranking will be determined by the number of gold, silver and bronze medals won by each club. In case of a new tie, the ranking will be determined by the number of competitors per club. As a last resort, the club that has earned the most points in the +87 kg category will be declared the winner (WT rules).</p>

4.4 Head kicks	⇒ Head kicks are NOT allowed for all Pee wees and C-class cadets.																				
	⇒ Head kicks are allowed for all AB-class cadets as well as for all juniors and seniors.																				
4.5 Weigh-in	⇒ A 99-gram excess will be tolerated during weigh-in.																				
	<u>Example :</u>																				
	- A competitor weighing 58,0 kg will compete in the -58 kg division.																				
	- A competitor weighing 58,1 kg will compete in the -63 kg division.

6 RESPONSIBILITY

6.1 Federation

6.2 Competitors

- ⇒ All competitors must be in possession of their 2019 license and insurance
- ⇒ All competitors must be in possession of their ID card or passport.
- ⇒ All competitors enter the competition at their own risk.
- ⇒ The organising club and ABFT decline any responsibility in the event of physical damage, violent behavior, injury or theft.
- ⇒ Foreign competitors who are underage in their country must be in possession of their signed accountability document (see attached). This document authorises underage competitors to take part in the competition and needs to be handed in during registration.

6.3 Coach


- ⇒ Free entry for 1 coach with a maximum of 5 competitors.
 - 1 to 5 competitors: 1 coach
 - 6 to 10 competitors: 2 coaches
 - 11 to 15 competitors: 3 coaches
 - ...
- ⇒ **12 € fee per additional coach.**
- ⇒ Coaches must wear sporting attire.
- ⇒ Coaches must be at least 18 years old.
- ⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their ID card or passport.
- ⇒ All BTF-affiliated (ABFT-TVDSG-VTB) coaches must be in possession of their Coach card.
- ⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their 2019 license/insurance.

6.4 First Aid

A doctor will be in attendance throughout the competition.

6.5 Protectors	⇒ WT-recognised protectors are mandatory for all categories (head protector, mouthguard, forearm protectors, shin protectors, groin guard, foot protectors), including categories where head kicks are not allowed.
6.6 Protests	Challenges to a referee's decision can only be made by the Head Coach immediately after the end of a fight. The coach will need to fill out the appropriate form provided by the organiser, subject to a 50 € fee per challenge. The fee will be reimbursed in the event that the challenge is granted to the coach. The Referee Chairman's decision will be the only one deemed as valid.

7 Registration

7.1 Registration Deadline	<p>⇒ No registration will be permitted after 03/11/2019</p> <p>⇒ No changes in weight division will be permitted after this date, except on the day of the competition (before or after weigh-in).</p> <p>⇒ No registration will be permitted on the day of the competition</p>

7.3 Competitors Number	A maximum of 420 entries will be accepted for this competition.
