Tournament Outline

Procedure:

- Clubs should register for the event in advance using www.ma-regonline.com
- Each Competitor and Coach must be entered accurately, including their British Taekwondo Membership Number (UK competitors only)
- Once the entry deadline has been reached the competitor list will go to the British Taekwondo License Audit
- Competitors whose license has not been renewed by this date will not pass the audit
- Competitors not passing the audit will be removed from the entry list for the tournament and will not be permitted to compete
- Coaches not passing the audit will not be permitted to coach
- Competitors not passing the audit will be charged the full entry fee by the event organiser

Eligibility of Applicants:

- All competitors must have a valid British Taekwondo license and insurance or those if competing from abroad must have a valid license through their National Association; numbers will be checked with Membership Services.
- All competitors should check that their insurance is valid and ensure that Jan 2020 renewals are sent to Membership Services with enough time to be processed and returned back before the competition closing date of 24th Jan 2020.

- Each competitor pays £35 to enter the tournament
- No-shows/withdrawals: Clubs will be expected to pay for competitors that do not show up or do not compete
- Audit fails: Clubs will be expected to pay for competitors that do not Membership Services' audit
- Spectators £7 per person, FREE for under 5s

Competition Draw:

- The competition draw will take place after the weigh in on **Sunday 02 February 2020** and will be posted on www.ma-regonline.com.
- Where only 1 competitor remains in a group following the weigh in, they will be merged into another group using the following guidelines:
- ❖ A and B class groups may be merged if necessary, and may not necessarily use Dae Do PSS for scoring
- ❖ Competitors may be moved up 1 weight group only

Rules:

- Full WT rules to be applied, including full contact to the body and head shots for all age and skill groups
- See "Scoring Systems for this Event" page for how scoring will be conducted
- There will be a meeting for all coaches at approximately 9.15am for any updates to the competition schedule and opportunity to ask any questions

Instant Video Review (IVR):

- There will be no Video Replay system for this tournament
- However, a Referee Review card appeal system will be utilised in accordance with British Taekwondo competition practices

Weigh In:

Saturday 01 February 2020

- There will be a weigh in at the competition venue from 4pm to 6pm
- Calibrated digital scales will be used, and a maximum of 0.099kg (99 grams) leniency will be granted
- competitors attempting to weigh in at this session will not be permitted to re-try the following day
- Changes to weight groups at this time will require an administration fee of £10
- competitors entered into the wrong age/Class categories will require an administration fee of £10

Sunday 02 February 2020

- There will be a weigh in on the morning of the competition at the competition venue 8.00am – 9.00am
- Calibrated digital scales will be used, and a maximum of 0.099kg (99 grams) leniency will be granted

Protests:

- Any protests must be made by the club coach within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Chief Referee.
- The Protest fee is £75 (refunded if protest is won).

Awards:

- Each Sparring Court will also award "Best Match of the day" trophies
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medal awards shall be made for each category.
- The top 3 teams will each receive a trophy to celebrate their top 3 standing by points awarded as follows:
 - ❖ Gold - 7pts, Silver - 3pts, Bronze - 1pt, 3 pts for each win



Behavior:

- All participants – spectators, competitors, coaches, officials – are expected to behave in an appropriate manner
- Any inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with by the competition organiser and offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board
- We support British Taekwondo's policy of ZERO TOLERANCE on swearing – and include in this, racist behaviour and extreme violent remarks of any nature – offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board and police where appropriate

The Competition Organiser has the right to make any necessary changes to the above information.

- All competitors participate at their own risk, and neither the organisers nor the British Taekwondo shall accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.

British Taekwondo Audit & Withdraws:

- Any player who fails an eligibility audit conducted by British Taekwondo that is registered or withdraws after being entered on ma-regonline.com is still liable to pay

Scoring Systems for this event

KN&P Body & Head Gear will be provided by the host for all Children, Cadet, Junior, Senior and Veteran A-class weight classes. Socks will be available to use on the day for those players who do not have their own.

All players must wear the correct PPE recognised by World Taekwondo. Groin, Arm, Leg, Gloves & clear/white mouth- piece. All novice and kids weight classes will play on non- PSS and provide their own Body Armour & Head Gear as well as their PPE.

All players will be required to pass inspection for officials to check the equipment for safety and compliance to WT Rules. Any player wearing non-recognised equipment will not be allowed to compete.

Manual scoring

Competitors will need to bring their own head guard, gum shield, body protector, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard and shin guards. All must be WT or British Taekwondo approved.

Electronic head & body scoring

Competitors will need the same protective gear as Manual scoring, with the exception of the body protector, head guard and sensor socks which will be provided by the tournament organisers.
