Registration Instructions

- Clubs must register in advance via www.ma-regonline.com
- All competitors and coaches must be entered accurately, including British Taekwondo Membership Number (UK competitors only)
- Competitors who do not pass the audit will be removed from the entry list and not permitted to compete
- Coaches who do not pass the audit will not be permitted to coach
- Competitors failing the audit will be charged the full entry fee
- All competitors must ensure their insurance is valid on the competition date

Classes & Competition System

Peewee/Children:

A Class: 3rd Kup and above (Red Tag and above)

B Class: 6th to 4th Kup (Green Belt to Blue Belt)

C Class: 9th Kup to 7th Kup (Yellow Tag to Green Tag Belt)

Cadets/Juniors/Seniors:

A Class: 4th Kup and above (Blue Belt and above)

B- Class: 9th Kup to 5th Kup (Yellow tag to Blue Tag)

- Please note White Belts are not allowed to compete for safety reasons.
- Where only 1 competitor remains in a group following the weigh in, they will be merged into another group using the following guidelines:
- A & B class group will not be merged
- Competitors may be moved up 1 weight group only

Rules

- Full WT rules to be applied, including full contact to the body and head shots for all age and skill groups
- Competitors will need to bring their own head guard, gumshield, body protector, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard and shin guards. Peewee and Children are allowed to wear helmets with visors for the B and C class categories. All must be WT or British Taekwondo approved. For those competing in the Advance categories (except Peewees), Competitors will need the same protective gear as Manual scoring, with the exception of the body protector and head guard which will be provided by the tournament organisation. Competitors will also require KPNP electronic sensor socks.

Appeals

- Referee Review Card appeal system in line with British Taekwondo practice

Weigh-In Procedures

- Calibrated digital scales will be used and 0.1kg (100g tolerance for underwear for Peewees and Children categories).
- Changes to weight groups as well as wrong age/class entries will incur a charge of £25 admin fee

Entry Fees & Withdrawals

- £55 per entry. Non-payment will result in entries being removed from the Open
- Clubs are expected to pay for competitors that do not show up or do not compete
- Withdrawals: 50% penalty fee will incur if removed between 19-25 July 2026 (5pm). Withdrawals made from 26 July 2026 will incur a full fee

Protests

- Any protest must be made by the club coach within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Chief Referee
- The Protest fee is £50 (refunded if protest is won)

Behaviour & Conduct

- All participants are expected to behave appropriately
- Organiser will address misconduct; offenders may be asked to leave or reported to BT Disciplinary Board

Liability

- Organiser reserves right to make changes
- Competitors participate at own risk
- Organiser & British Taekwondo not responsible for damages, injuries, or losses
