May I stress that due to time constraints the number of competitors will be limited to 300 for Kyorugi. On this occasion we have A and B class for Peewees, where A class peewees will play under full WTF rules, and B class Peewees will not do headkicks. Applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis. **Our previous competitions have been over subscribed we have turned clubs away before the closing date.**

****INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS****

In line with recent changes in the BTCB Event Guidelines, I remind you that all competitors AND coaches must have a valid licence with them on the day and **present it at the weigh in / registration**.

We still require that all competitors and coaches submit details of their insurance on application. These will be checked against the national database.

Your assistance in this is greatly appreciated, and will help ensure that the weigh in finishes on time, and the rest of the day can run smoothly.

Entries can be submitted via the website www.ma-regonline.com. You should note there is a "early bird / reduced" entry fee for those players submitting entries and payment before the beginning of October.

The **closing date** for applications is the Saturday **16th October**. I look forward to receiving your clubs applications, and please do not hesitate to contact us, preferably by email (above), if you have any further questions.
