18. Insurance All competitors must have a valid BTCB licence and must be produced at weigh-in. Coaches must be at the age of 18 plus, must have a valid BTCB licence and an instructor's insurance in order to obtain a coach pass. One coach pass will be issued for every five competitors.
19. Awards Medals for 1st, 2nd and joint 3rd place.
Team Trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
20. Protests Only the official coach is permitted to lodge a protest, immediately after the contest to the Chief Referee with £50.00 protest fee. The decision of the chief referee is final.
21. Medical Cover Doctor and first aid team.
22. Liability This competition is fully insured under the BTCB/BTC insurance policies. The London Team and the organisers assume no responsibility for any theft of personal belongings.
23. Photography and Video Recording - BY you registering online you are agreeing for the picture to be taken by the press and members of the public. In addition in the interests of Child Protection the BTCB requires ANY person (relative, friend, coach or other official) wishing to engage in photography or video recording (including the use of mobile phones as recording equipment) to register their intent using the Photography Registration form provided at the Venue from the administration team. The Photography Registration form must be completed and then submitted to the event organiser on the day of the competition. Many coaches wish to use video facilities at events in order to provide feedback for their students and by entering your child for this event you are accepting that they may be photographed or videoed and are therefore providing the necessary consent.
24. Note Instructors/ Coaches will be held responsible for any misbehaviour of their Club Representative including parents. In the vent of behaviour deemed inappropriate by the organisers the entire Club will be asked to leave the competition immediately and no refunds will be offered.
